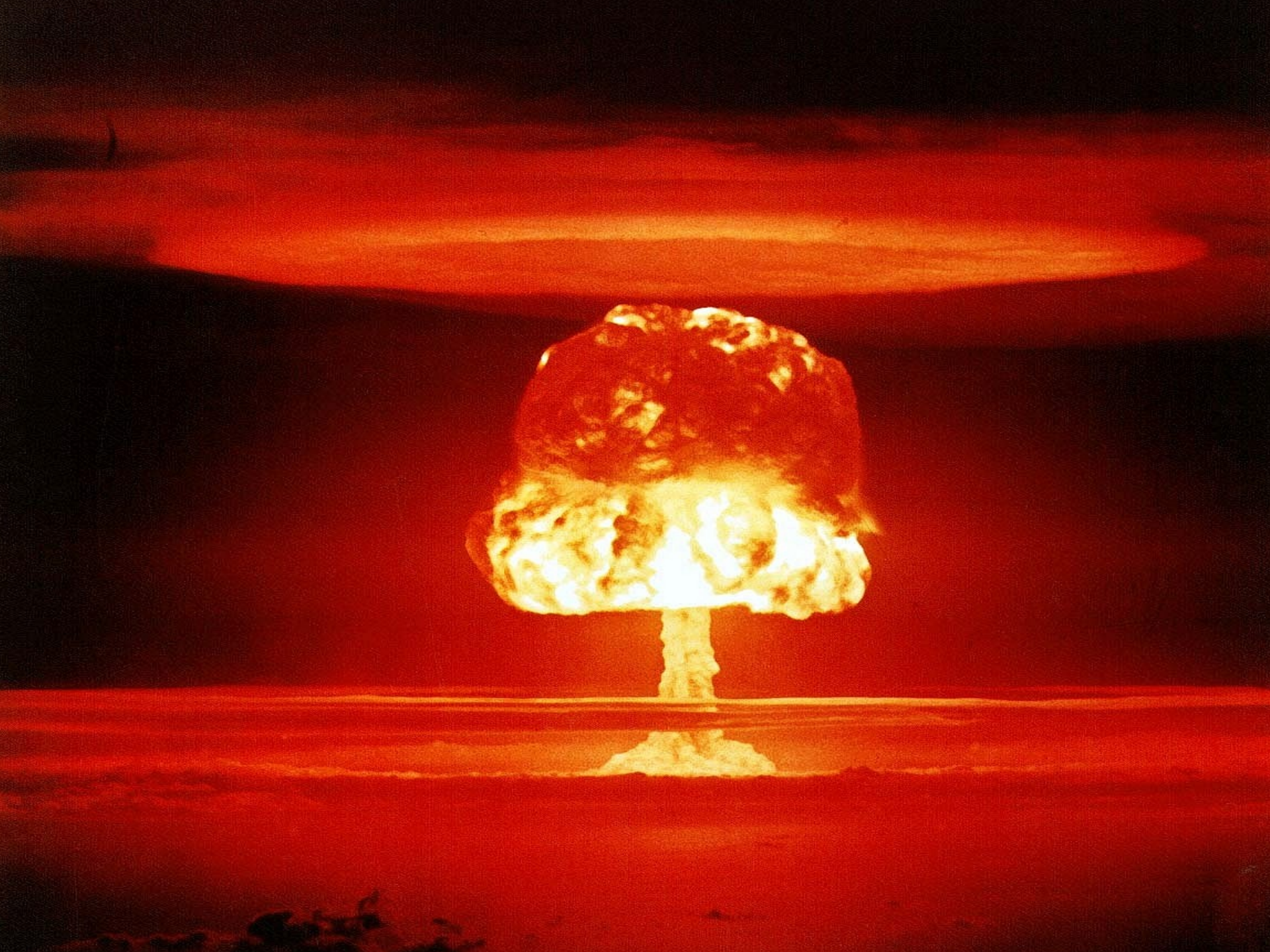


Air Temperature Anomaly, Units: °C

## European publishers want a law to control online news access

A group of European publishers has signed a declaration that aims to see its ...

The desertion of advertising dollars from the ailing print media industry has left publishers searching for more of the one thing that the Internet seems intent on denying them: paying customers. Print publications in the US and Europe are scrambling to find ways to charge somebody—readers, link aggregators, blogs, competitors—for deriving any sort of benefit from the reporting they're doing.

A group of European publishers has recently released a declaration of principles, the "Hamburg Declaration," that amounts to a long-winded rant against the Internet for stealing their news. They want the government to step in and fix the situation by force of law.

Most of the statements in the [relatively short declaration](#), which will surely take its place among thousands of other European declarations on intellectual property and other matters that have come out over the past few years, hinge on the idea that "universal access to news" does not equal "free." In this respect, the publishers want to maintain the democratic ideal of a "fourth estate" that provides news to an informed citizenry, while simultaneously restricting access to that news to those who can pay for it directly.

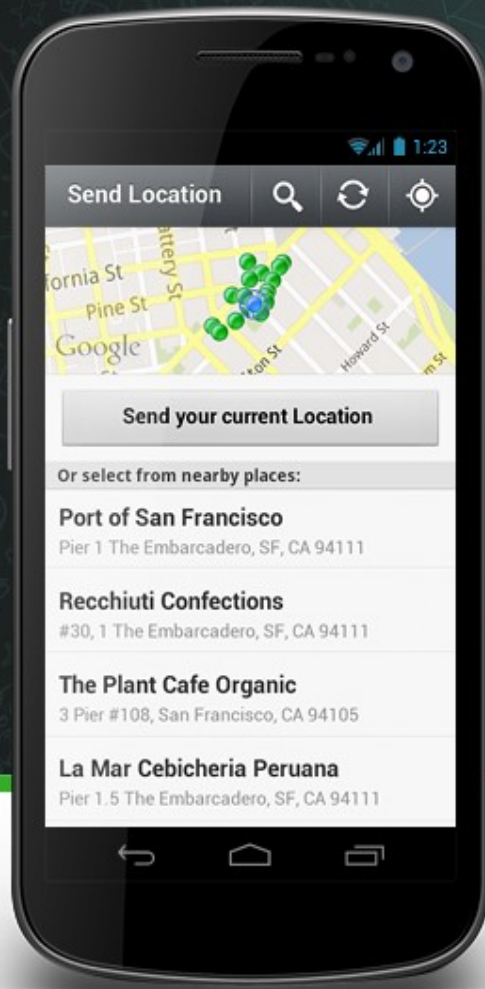

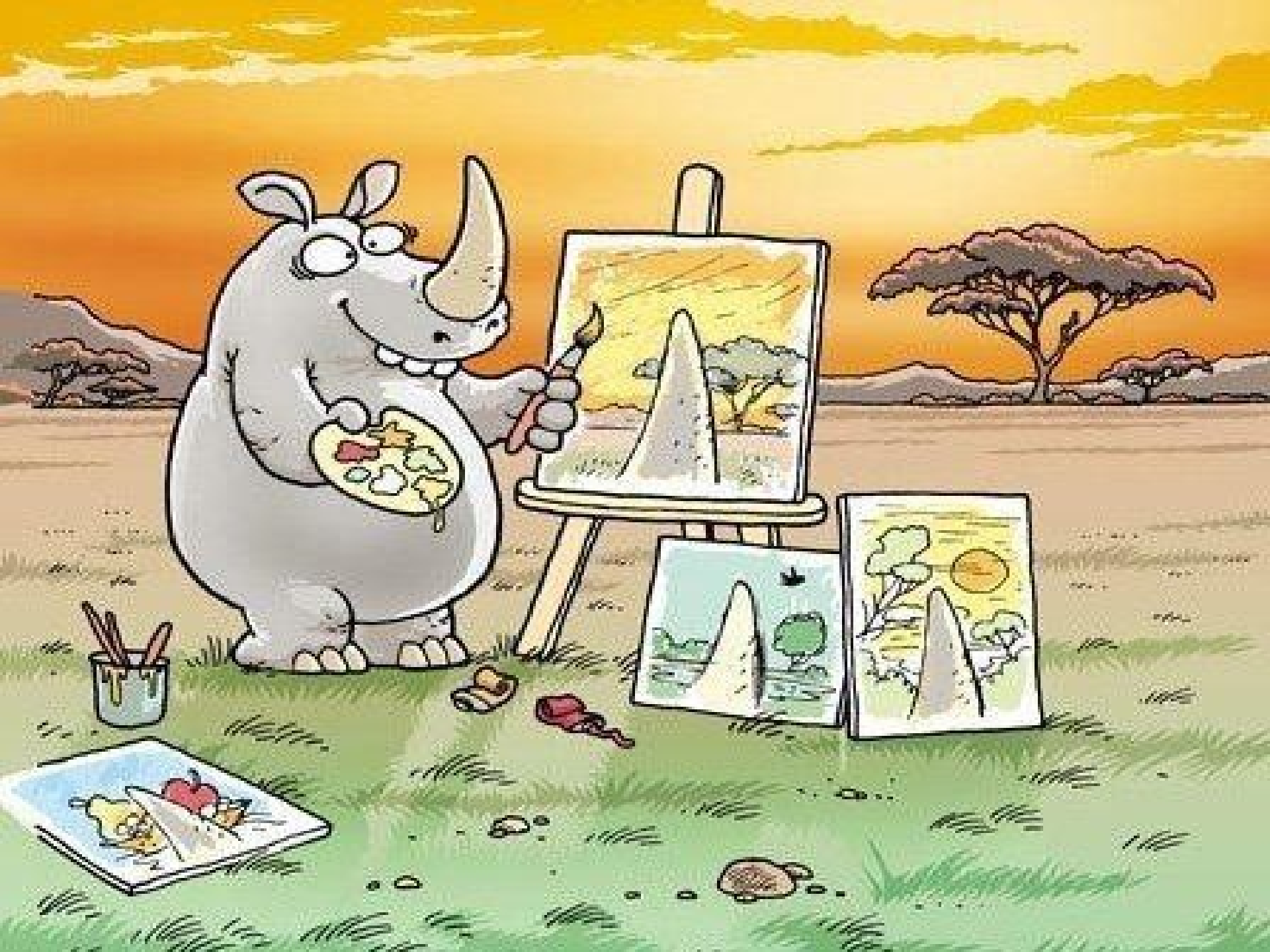

**Nederlandse bedrijven en organisaties die clouddiensten afnemen in Amerika zijn zelf eindverantwoordelijk voor de bescherming van persoonsgegevens, betoogt het CBP.**

Het College Bescherming Persoonsgegevens (CBP) heeft stelling genomen in de discussie rond het omstreden Safe Harbor-keurmerk.

Het college meent dat Nederlandse bedrijven en organisaties altijd zelf eindverantwoordelijk zijn. Bij overeenkomsten met Amerikaanse clouddiensten moeten zij zelf risicoanalyse uitvoeren en dataprotectie indien nodig met wettelijke regels afdekken, schrijft het CBP in zijn betoog.

### **Structureel misbruik**

Safe Harbor is een cruciale regeling tussen de EU en VS. Alleen als Amerikaanse bedrijven Safe Harbor-gecertificeerd zijn mogen zij privégegevens van Europese consumenten verwerken en opslaan. Het gaat om zeven principes, waaronder 'ondubbelzinnige toestemming' van en een opt-out mogelijkheid voor betrokkenen, passende databeveiliging, duidelijk omschreven handhaving en correcte klachtafhandeling.

# Superspyware Flame klaar voor nieuw offensief

**De rol van superspyware Flame is nog lang niet uitgespeeld. Onderzoekers van Kaspersky stellen dat het Flame-platform nog in ontwikkeling is en vermoeden dat er nieuwe malwarevarianten in omloop zijn.**

Na maandenlang de supermalware Flame te hebben bestudeerd, concluderen onderzoekers van Kaspersky dat er nog meer aan de hand is dan tot nu toe werd aangenomen. Zo zijn er sporen van nieuwe malwarevarianten in het wild aangetroffen en is er een nog nooit geïmplementeerd protocol ontdekt. Dit wijst erop dat de makers van Flame nog niet klaar zijn met de malwarecampagne.

## **Nieuw protocol**

Hoofdonderzoeker Marco Preuss van Kaspersky vertelt aan Webwereld dat de ontwikkeling van Flame nog altijd doorgaat. "Er zijn momenteel meerdere onderdelen die nog niet zijn geïmplementeerd", aldus Preuss. Kaspersky heeft malware opgepikt in zijn eigen sinkholes en daarin troffen de onderzoekers een nieuw protocol aan dat 'Red Protocol' is gedoopt.

"Het is niet duidelijk wat 'Red Protocol' precies doet, omdat de volledige definitie ervan ontbreekt", zegt Preuss. "We vonden verwijzingen die lijken aan te geven dat er nog steeds aan de ontwikkeling van het platform wordt gewerkt."

**De hackersgroep Rex Mundi claimt de klantgegevens van maar liefst 300 Belgische verzekeraars en kredietverstrekkers in handen te hebben en dreigt die openbaar te maken als er geen geld wordt betaald.**

De hackersgroep heeft [op Pastebin](#) de gehackte bedrijven op een rijtje gezet, vaak kleinere zelfstandige tussenpersonen die allemaal gebruik hebben gemaakt van eenzelfde content managementsysteem Modulink van aanbieder Webassur.

Dat systeem is door Rex Mundi gehackt en de achterliggende database met klantgegevens is volgens de hackers daardoor bloot komen te liggen. De gegevens van de 300 bedrijven waren allemaal in dezelfde sql-database opgeslagen, zeggen de hackers.

### **Hackers zijn berucht**

Volgens Security.nl hebben de hackers van Rex Mundi al eens eerder toegeslagen bij onder meer het Nederlandse uitzendbureau Accord. De gegevens die de hackers nu hebben buitgemaakt bestaan uit persoonlijke data van klanten en kredietaanvragen.

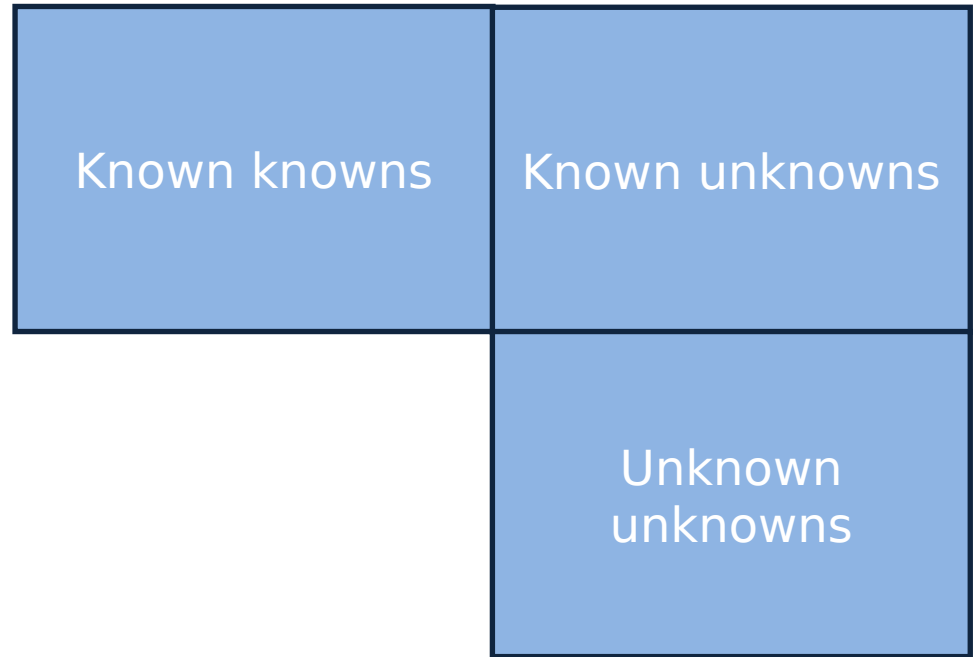
Rex Mundi heeft Webassur tot aan maandag de tijd gegeven om 5000 euro te betalen. Als daaraan niet wordt voldaan, wordt de data openbaar gemaakt. Webwereld heeft Webassur om een reactie gevraagd maar die nog niet gekregen.

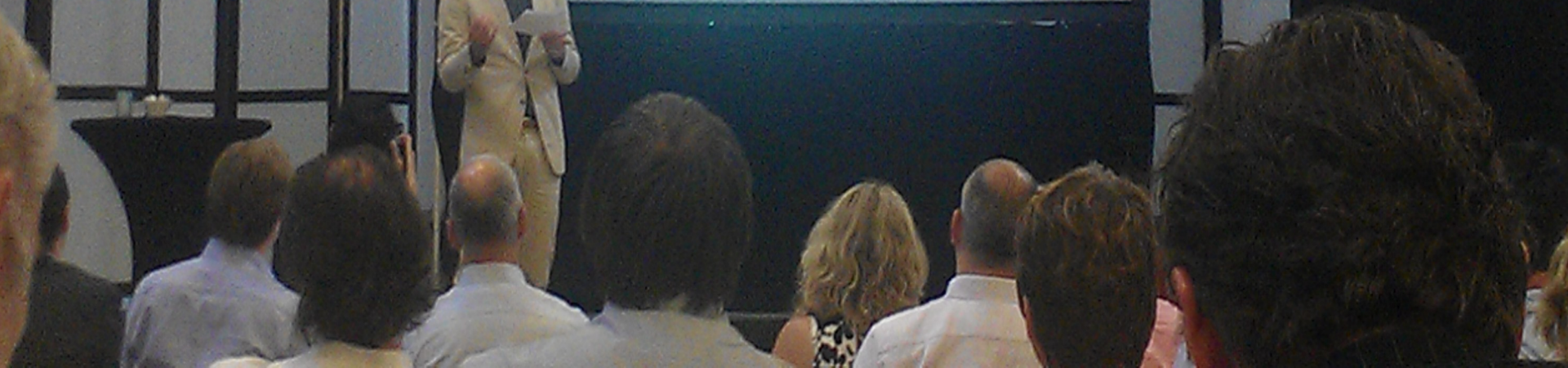
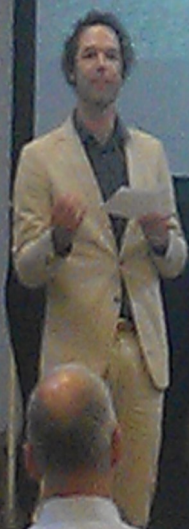
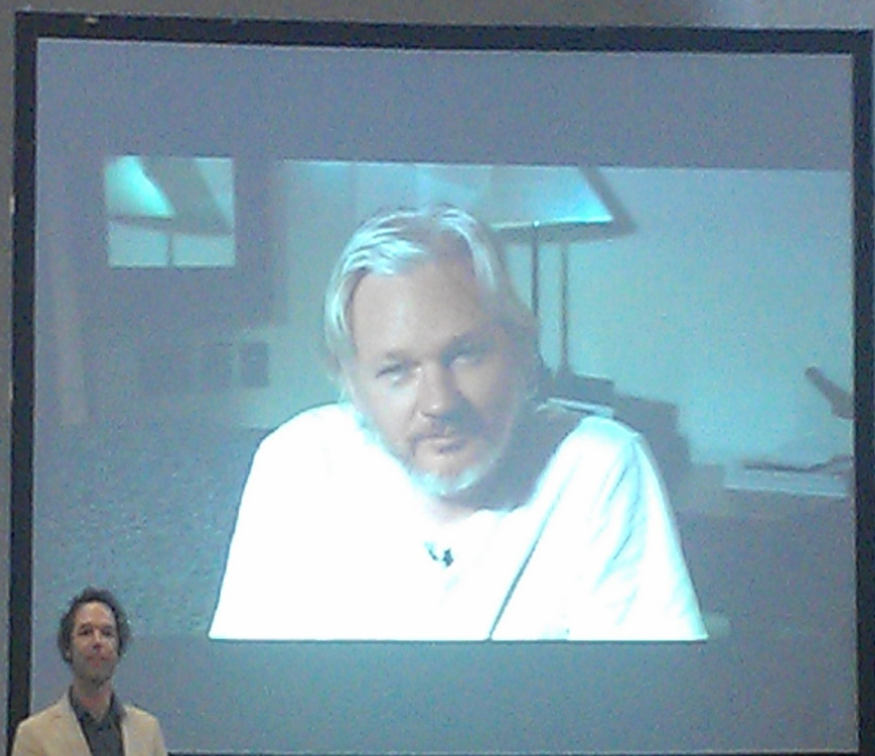

# The “Downing street memo”

**C reported on his recent talks in Washington. There was a perceptible shift in attitude. Military action was now seen as inevitable. Bush wanted to remove Saddam, through military action, justified by the conjunction of terrorism and WMD. But the intelligence and facts were being fixed around the policy. The NSC had no patience with the UN route, and no enthusiasm for publishing material on the Iraqi regime's record. There was little discussion in Washington of the aftermath after military action.**

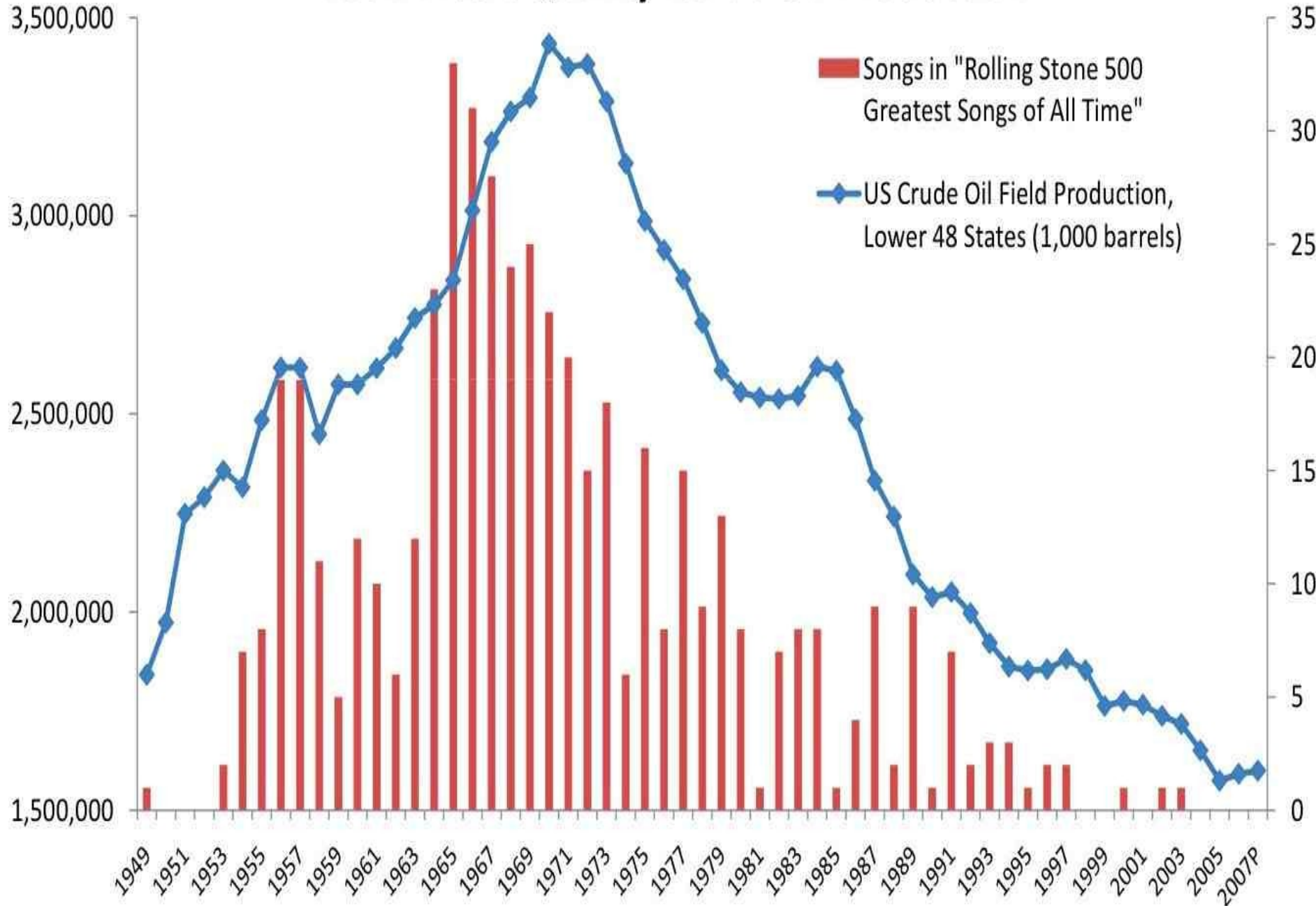

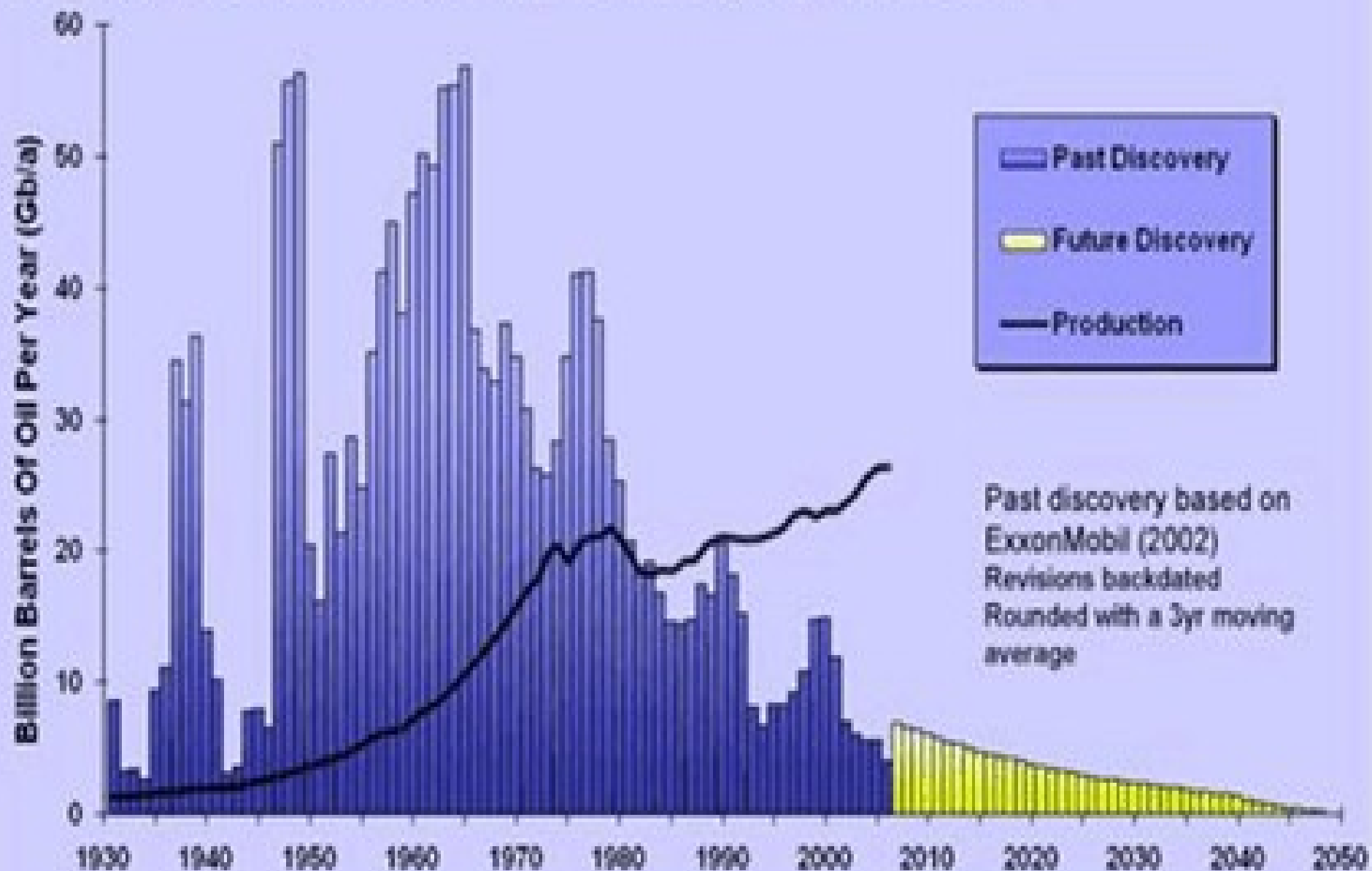

# Rock Music Quality vs. US Oil Production

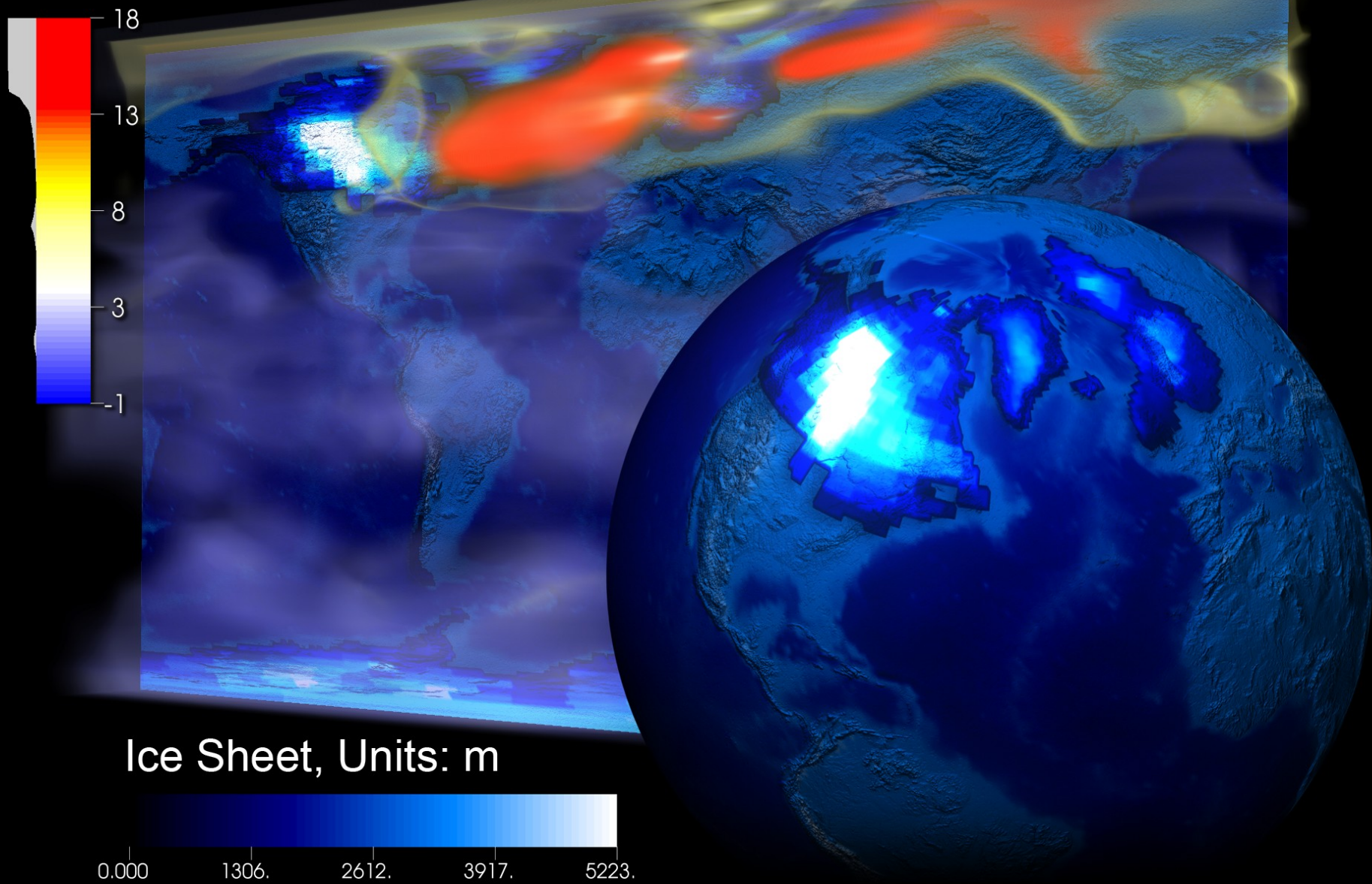

## Regular Conventional Oil: Discovery & Production

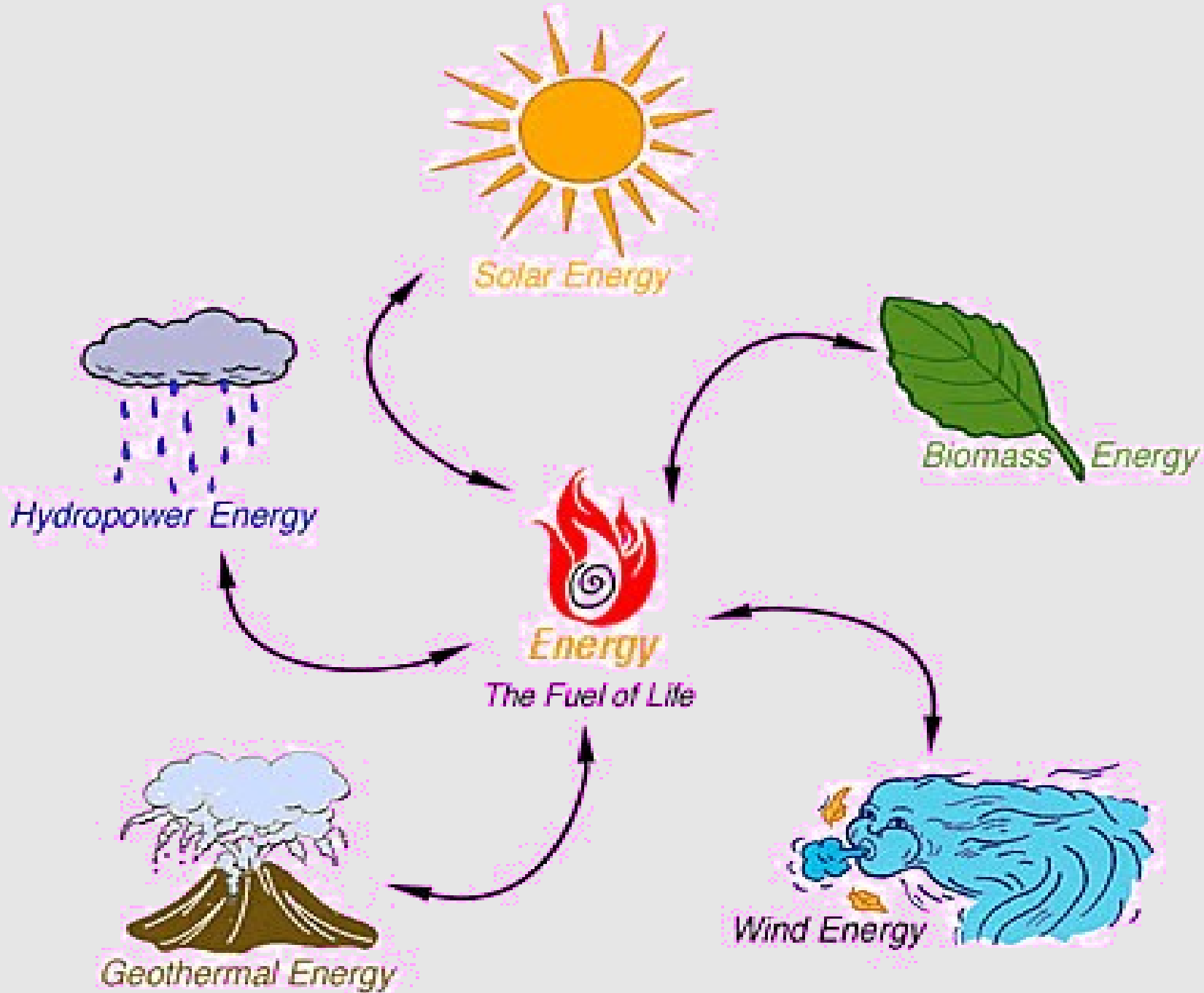


Air Temperature Anomaly, Units: °C
